



## Agreed SEEL statement on Professional Placements in Years 2 and 3

The following agreed statement applies to placements in Years 2 and 3 which involve 130 days – which approximates to 3 days per week in school term time. The Year 2/3 placements are made anonymously by a Placement Panel of 6 Principal Educational Psychologists, one each from each of the 3 SEEL regions (the South East, East and London). PEP Panel Chair, Programme Director and trainee representatives are available to the Placement Panel as advisors.
