

# Hire UCL students with data skills for a project this summer

UCL Social Data Institute provides some of the most extensive training in quantitative methods to undergraduates anywhere in the UK.

Students receive hands-on training in our innovative and inter-disciplinary degree programmes that focus on the research process: **experimental and non- experimental research design; identifying and asking good research questions; how to observe and measure concepts; choosing the right analytic technique; necessary application of statistical computation; visualizing data; communicating the results.**

Now in its 7th year, the internship programme places students with organisations either already working with data or who need some temporary data expertise.
